The body condition of horses based on the degree of fat cover is a good indicator of a horse's general health. The body condition score (BCS) allows one to access if the horse is too thin, too fat, or about right. Horses are scored on a scale from 1 (poor) to 9 (extremely fat) in six areas where they deposit fat - neck, withers, spinous processes (part of back vertebrae that project upwards) and transverse processes (portion of vertebrae that projects outward), tail head, ribs, and ...

Note that for acute conditions, body condition score may be unaffected. Assign a BCS of 1-5. Convert that to an end-stage illness score according to the statements below. Score (3): BCS 1 = Emaciated with no palpable fat over the sacroiliac region, severely reduced muscle mass, with prominent vertebrae and iliac crests (emaciated)

Ribs palpable with difficulty; heavy fat cover. Noticeable fat deposits over lumbar area and base of tail. Waist absent or barely visible. Abdominal tuck may be present.

### **Body Condition Score - WSAVA**

The BCS evaluates body fat [Figure 2]. Various BCS systems are used to evaluate dogs and cats (e.g., scales of 5, 6, 7 or 9). 11,12,13 The goal for most pets is a BCS of 2.5-3 of 5, or 4-5 of 9. (This may appear too thin to some pet owners, so client education is important.)

### **BCS and MCS - AAHA**

Body condition scores are numbers used to estimate energy reserves in the form of fat and muscle of beef cows. BCS ranges from 1 to 9, with a score of 1 being extremely thin and 9 being very obese. Areas such as the back, tail head, pins, hooks, ribs, and brisket of beef cattle can be used to determine BCS (Figure 1). Figure 1.

Body condition scoring in dairy cattle is a visual and tactile evaluation of body fat reserves using a 5-point scale with 0.25-point increments. Body condition scores (BCS) are an indirect estimate of energy balance. A score of 1 denotes a very thin cow, while 5 denotes an excessively fat cow, and 3 is an average body condition.
